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| Play your favorite song from a previous book | Do a search about a composer and find 3 facts about them | Change the name of one of your pieces; then change the settings on your keyboard to make it sound like its new name | Improvise a soundtrack for your favorite movie scene | Write a thank you note to your parents for letting you take lessons |
| Learn a song in your book that you were not assigned and record yourself | Play 3 songs for someone over a video call | Draw or paint a picture about a song in your book | Compose an 8-measure song about your favorite animal (include some creative sounds) | Interview someone who plays your favorite instrument |
| Find your favorite song on YouTube and try to learn to play the melody | Dress up according to the song you are playing and take a picture of yourself | Free Square | Interview your parents about their musical background | Create a dance routine to go with one of your songs |
| Listen to 1 song by each of the following: Beethoven Liszt Rachmaninoff | Record yourself playing a “song” with someone else in your family | Compose an 8-measure song about ice cream | Make a list of the top 3 songs you want to learn | Create a song (rhythm only) to play with someone in your family |
| Take a black and white photo of you with your instrument | Create a new melody for a nursery rhyme or poem | Interview a grandparent about their musical background | Teach someone in your family to play a song | Create a new instrument – record a video of yourself playing it |
